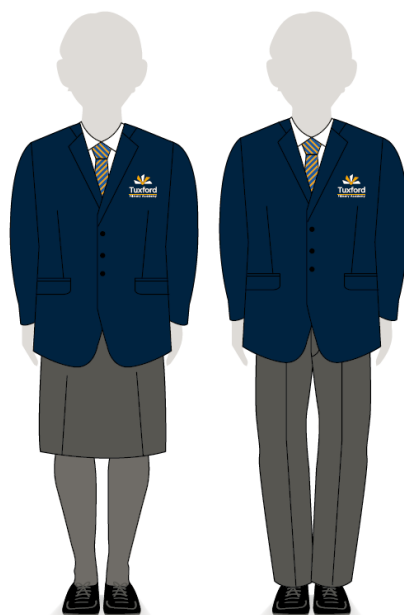

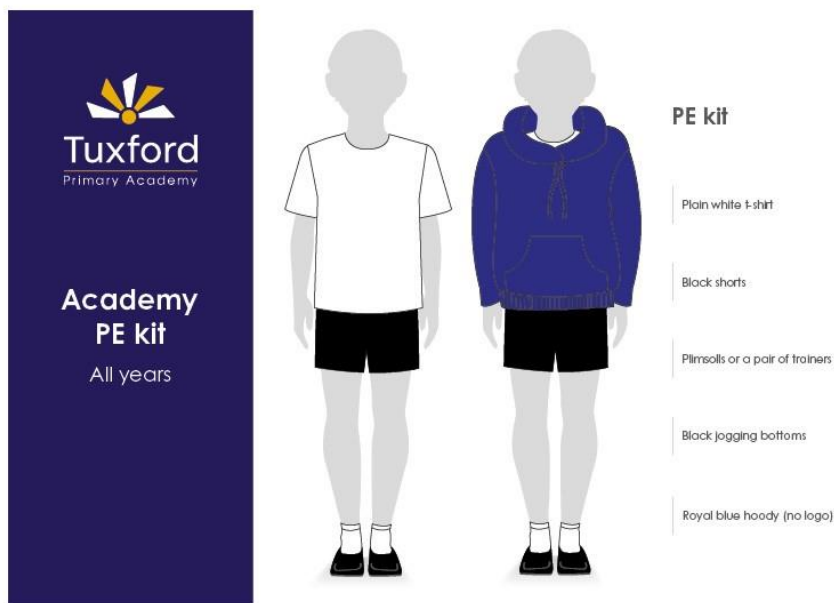

6. PE Kit

- Plain white t-shirt
- Black shorts
- Plimsolls or a pair of trainers
- Black jogging bottoms (no logo)



7. Hair, jewellery and labels

On health and safety grounds, we do not allow children to wear jewellery. However, if it is unavoidable, those with freshly pierced ears may wear one set of plain studs. These must be taken out during PE and should be left at home on these days if your child cannot manage to take them out themselves. Hair that is long enough must be tied back at all times with a plain, neutral coloured band or clips (no other hair accessories).

All clothing should be clearly labelled with your child's name. This is especially important, as uniform items look similar and can be easily confused with another pupil's. The academy cannot accept responsibility for any lost items.
