## Uniform Policy

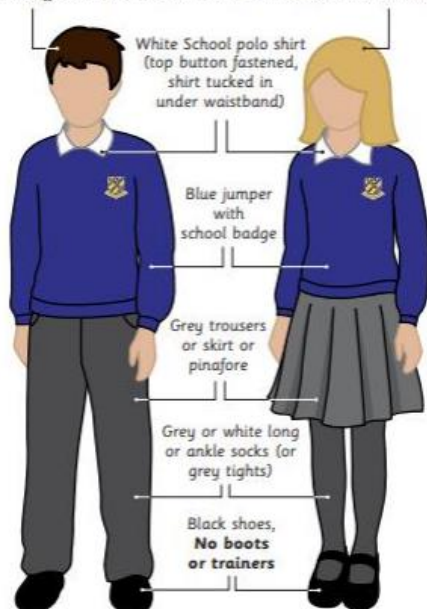
All uniform must be labelled with the child's first and surname.

### All pupils

Wellingtons for outdoor play – to be kept in school

#### School Uniform to Year 4

Long hair to be fully tied back. Extreme haircuts are not allowed, this includes different colours, tramlines, undercuts, mohawks and mohicans.



Jewellery should not be worn at school, however if unavoidable, those with freshly pierced ears may wear one set of plain studs. These must be taken out during P.E. and should be left at home on these days if you cannot manage to take them out yourself. Shorts and gingham dresses/playsuits can be worn up until October half-term and after the Easter holidays.

#### School Uniform Year 5 and 6

Long hair to be fully tied back with a plain bobble. Extreme haircuts are not allowed, this includes different colours, tramlines, undercuts, mohawks and mohicans.



Jewellery should not be worn at school, however if unavoidable, those with freshly pierced ears may wear one set of plain studs. These must be taken out during P.E. and should be left at home on these days if you cannot manage to take them out yourself. Shorts can be worn up until October half-term and after the Easter holidays.

### For physical education and games children should wear:

- A royal blue t-shirt or polo shirt with academy logo
- Black shorts or royal blue academy shorts or skort
- Plimsolls or a pair of trainers

For outdoor PE during colder months

- academy tracksuit with a PE T-shirt underneath alternatively black or blue tracksuit (plain without brand logos or stripes) and an academy T-shirt with logo

**Please can you make sure all clothes are labelled with your child's name.**

### **Jewellery**

Jewellery should not be worn at school, however if unavoidable, those with freshly pierced ears may wear one set of plain studs. These must be taken out during P.E. and should be left at home on these days if your child cannot manage to take them out themselves. Stickers and plasters over earrings are not allowed.

### **Hair**

Hair that is long enough must be tied back at all times with a plain, neutral coloured band or clips (no other hair accessories).

Extreme hairstyles are not allowed, this includes different colours, tramlines, undercuts (hair must be graded not shaved short around the sides and sudden length on top so that it hangs over the shaven sides), mohawks and mohicans.
